# The SALISES- Haiti Outreach (SHOUT) Project Appeal, 2024

## To all the Friends of Haiti

The Sir Arthur Lewis Institute of Social and Economic Studies (SALISES), at The University of the West Indies (UWI), has embarked on an outreach and support effort for the children of Haiti. In particular, we have launched a project, coordinated by Dr Patricia Northover, Senior Fellow, (SALISES) to support, in the first instance, a co-educational kindergarten and primary school, the Ecole Vision Mondiale, (Global Vision School), founded in 2005 and led by the Principal, Pastor Calixte Issalem. This school caters to some 200 children, boys and girls from ages 3-17, who reside near to the Haiti-Dominican Republic Border, in the region of Lascohobas. The institution is located in a depressed rural area in the Quimpe VI locality of the Lascahobas municipality, in the Central Department of Haiti and is registered with the Lascahobas School District Office (BDSL) at number 35. Unfortunately, the community the school serves has been devastated by the border closure as cross border trading was a main means of survival.

This SALISES-Haiti outreach (SHOUT) effort is underpinned by a three (3) year Memorandum of Understanding signed in December 2022, between The University of the West Indies, the Haiti Jamaica Society and the Ecole Vision Mondiale (Global Vision School). The project is also managed by an oversight board and the project finances will be managed through a fund established by The University's Office of Finance.

With the support of The Haiti-Jamaica Society (HJS), a non-governmental organization (NGO) and registered company for charity led by Ms. Myrtha Désulmé, its founder and president, we are seeking to meet needs in the form of financial support for a school feeding programme, uniforms and back to school supplies, sanitation facilities and classroom upgrades, and a subsidy for teacher's salaries that *have not been paid for a year* due to the crises in Haiti. The project funding **goal over 3 years is US\$250,000. We are in urgent need of US\$50,000 for the new semester (Spring 2024) for classroom supplies, teachers and school feeding needs to enable the school to open.**
